



Ute Meyer: Picture "Baltic Sea / Tranderup / Ærø" (2010)

This picture was taken in April directly on location on the coast of the Danish Baltic Sea island Ærø. It shows a green, grassy path to the water. The path is embedded in two slopes, which are also covered with light green vegetation between which light, ocher-colored sand emerges. The Baltic Sea shimmers turquoise blue. White spray breaks on the shore. The cloudless blue sky shines above the horizon in delicate yellow tones. The brushstroke is impasto and emphasizes the structures of the vegetation and the water. The picture carrier is a stretcher frame with self-covered and triple primed linen. A steel cable serves as a suspension. The edges are painted.
