



Ute Meyer: Picture "Baltic Sea / Ærø / St. Albert" (2022)

This picture was taken in September on a very windy day on the Danish island of Ærø. Ute Meyer had to stand in the lee of the car and put down the canvas. The sea is blue-green offset with white spray. In the light gray sky some blue shines out between the n cloud banks. The autumn colored ocher grass bends in the wind. In front at the edge of the picture are the light blue flowers of a chicory to see. The oil paint is spatulaed and the impasto application of paint gives the picture dynamics and plasticity. The picture support is a self-covered and triple primed canvas, which is provided with a steel cable as a suspension. The edges are white. The picture can be hung without framing.
